Outline of Research	This study aims to identify psychosocial factors that enhance quality of life for parents of adolescents and young adults with autism. Participation in this research involves completing a self-report questionnaire that asks about parental expectations, concerns, support network and the strategies used to manage everyday life. It is hoped that identification of these factors will facilitate the development of interventions that improve quality of life for families of adult dependents with Autism Spectrum Disorder.
